

**VRPA COVID-19 Safety Plan For Recreation Centres**  
**Sep 2020**

**Policies Guidelines Procedures**

- limit numbers
- maintain attendance records for contact tracing purposes
- ingress/egress – Recreation centre will provide information on this
- COVID screening – questions asked prior to each session and at controlled, distanced entry to Field House
- require waiver which includes CDC symptoms and testing link of <http://www.bccdc.ca/health-info/diseases-conditions/covid-19/about-covid-19/symptoms>
- handwashing and hygiene – washrooms and hand sanitizer will be available at entrance.
- players are encouraged to use their own hand sanitizer and use it before/after play
- equipment handling – Recreation centre will provide nets and court space only
- first aid – Recreation centre will provide this

Session conduct of participants and facilitators

- participants enter dressed to play with minimal personal belongings and sit in on one, specific chair, appropriately spaced from others, throughout the session
- participant supply their own, clearly marked pickleballs
- facilitator gathers contact information and waiver from any substitute players

Systems

- Reporting COVID-19 related symptoms – Use Recreation centre's form and process
- Reporting unsafe acts or conditions – Recreation centre contact
- Designating a health and safety worker – designate and inform re Saanich personnel contact
